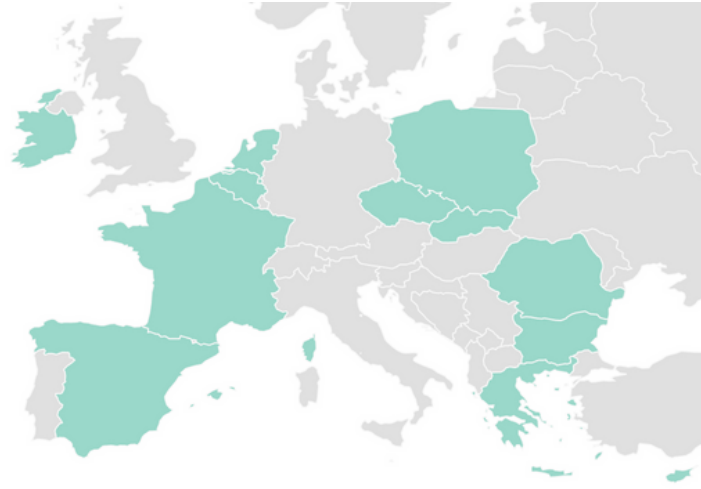

# TRADICIL PROJECT

On 14 February 2025, the TRADICIL project kicked off. This new training project, coordinated by ELF and run together with the Council of Bars and Law Societies of Europe and 11 EU national, regional and local Bars, aims to train at least 816 EU lawyers in two very relevant areas of EU law: digitalisation of justice; and EU legal instruments in civil law (family law and succession).

Whereas the training on digitalisation will be undertaken through 2 big hybrid events (one in 2025 and another in 2026) for lawyers across the EU, the training in civil law will be carried out through seminars to be attended by lawyers of Bars which are partnering in the civil law part of the project.

# END TO TRALIM 3 ACTIVITIES

The very successful training project TRALIM 3 came to an end on 14 March 2025. A lot of work was undertaken by ELF and its project partners, which included the holding of 21 training activities (seminars on EU immigration and asylum law, seminars on vulnerable groups of migrants and short visits to reception centres or other institutions dealing with immigrants and asylum seekers in 6 EU Member States).

However, the end of the project does not mean that its lasting effects are over. Further to the knowledge that participants in the training events gained, we have also made available (free of charge) the training material developed in the framework of the training events as well as a manual on best practices in immigration and asylum in the jurisdictions represented by the project partners.
